10. After Jesus died and rose from the dead, He secretly appeared to two men traveling on the road to Emmaus. How did they finally realize who He was? (24:13–35)

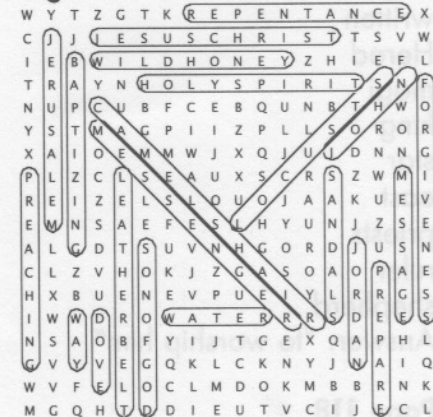

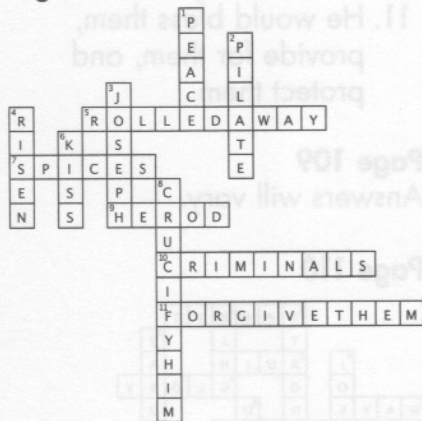
